



## Grayson will celebrate Canada Day in style

Grayson is a village of 179 people located in the RM of Grayson and centrally located 25 miles south of Melville, 25 miles north of Grenfell and 25 miles west of Esterhazy.

The village was originally called Nieven, but in 1904, the CPR came through and renamed it Grayson, for Harry Grayson a construction contractor. The village was incorporated April 19, 1906.



That information and a lot more is documented in the recently published Grayson and District History Book.

The village will celebrate Canada Day in fine style this year. Festivities begin the night before Canada Day. Organizers plan a bandstand show and fireworks display at dusk.

Grayson is also located 10 miles north of Crooked Lake, with its water sports, golfing and camping facilities just a short drive away.



## Killaly celebrates centennial birthday

Killaly is a village of 77 residents located at the junction of Highways 22 and 47, 22 km south of Melville and only 10 km north of the Qu'Appelle Valley.

This year the community plans to celebrate its centennial birthday party, July 18. At press time details of the planned centennial events were not available.

Killaly has a post office, a Roman Catholic Church and a senior citizens' lodge. The Golden Age Club is very active in the village and is currently planning to turn its building into a community center to serve everyone in the area.

The annual outdoor Mariahilf Catholic Mass will be held on the last Sunday of July at 11 a.m. and everyone is welcome. In winter the village hosts an annual snowmobile derby, usually in January.
