



Grenfell Snowbusters enjoy valley winter

With a current membership of more than 30 families, the snowmobile club has been quite active in providing winter recreation for the avid and family snowmobile enthusiasts.

Warm-up shelters halfway between the town of Grenfell and the Qu'Appelle Valley and in the Pipesone Valley south of the town provide a social meeting place for riders of all ages. Facilities at the shelter provide everything needed for all types of gatherings.

The Broadview Snowbusters groom all the trails, which make all rides safe and easy. Approximately 80 kilometers of trail between the Melville trails and the Windthorst Trail provide the connecting link between the North and the South toward Kenosee Provincial Park.

The Grenfell Trails, 313A and 313B, which are all marked with signs, distance and map posted, provide a safe and relaxing travel northward to the Qu'Appelle Valley and southward through the Pipestone Valley to Windthorst. The Qu'Appelle Valley Trail north travels through the Sakimay First Nations where fuel and confectionary services are provided. The town of Grenfell offers all the necessities for the daily riders and the services and accommodations for overnight stays. A medical centre, ambulance service and a rescue sled are available in case of emergencies or assistance.

The Qu'Appelle Valley has many scenic trails winding through woodlands, a changing variety of terrain and a wide extending lake.

The club has a yearly snowmobile derby — this winter in January — and a complimentary community wiener roast at the end of the snowmobile season.

Every year the Snowdrifters hold a hot dog roast during Grenfell's Canada Day celebrations. The club also hosts an annual rally in late January.

Stop in and enjoy a fun time snowmobiling the Grenfell Snowdrifters trails.
