Echo Valley Provincial Park lies within and overlooking the scenic Qu'Appelle Valley.

Come and enjoy a wide range of activities. Electric, non-electric and group campsites are available and can be rented by

the day/month or at a special season rate.

Three creative playgrounds are located at the park for the children's entertainment as well as a miniature golf course that the whole family can enjoy.

Two beaches with lush green lawns and picnic sites can provide a great day of entertainment.

Walk the three kilometer Qu'Appelle Interpretive Trail, visit the Visitor Centre, try mountain biking on the cross country ski trails, cycle along the lakes or attend recreation programs organized by our recreation staff.



Boat launch facilities provide access to both Echo and Pasqua Lakes. A modern fish filleting building will be well appreciated after catching your limit of walleye, perch and northern pike which abound in the four lakes.

The lakes are also popular spots for water-skiing, windsurfing or pleasure boating.

Make Echo Valley Provincial Park your home while exploring the valley and enjoying the many other attractions in and around Fort Qu'Appelle.

Some attractions that you may enjoy are the Echo Ridge nine hole grass green golf course, museum, two nine-hole golf courses near Katepwa Provincial Park and nearby W.R. Motherwell Homestead.
