

Melville Bison head into another season



The Melville Bison senior baseball team is in its seventh season since rejoining the South East Senior Baseball League (SESBL).

The Bison took a leave of absence several years ago when the Melville Major Millionaires were formed to compete in the Sask Major Baseball League (SMBL).

A shift in player personnel prompted by the expansion of the SMBL resulted in the Bison rejoining the SESBL.

The Bison feature 100 per cent local content and play their home games at Pirie Field in the Melville Regional Park.

They typically compete against teams from Yorkton, Canora, Saltcoats, Willowbrook, Grandview and Swan River which was new to the league last season. Two new teams joined the league for this season in the Yorkton Yankees and the Parkland Padres.

The Bison won the league championship two out of three years by defeating current champion Canora three years ago.
