## Village of Lebert a valley jewel

Crowned by the century-old Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church, the Village of Lebert is a jewel among the Qu'Appelle Valley's many attractions.

Situated just a few minutes drive from Fort Qu'Appelle, Balcarres, Qu'Appelle, Indian Head and Katepwa, Lebert sits snugly in the valley overlooking beautiful Mission Lake.

While the Stations of the Cross and the Little Chapel on the hill remind us of the past, the future lies with residents and businesses, such as the Calling Lakes Inn, Lebert Groceries and Lebert Antiques and Collectibles.

The community also features a museum which displays the colorful history of the region. It is open from May through September. The history buffs will be interested to know the last buffalo hunter, the first Lebert homesteader and Lebert's only doctor are all buried at the Lebert Cemetery.
