



Crooked Lake Prov. Park

Situated in a scenic portion of the Qu'Appelle Valley featuring mixed prairie grass, groves of trembling aspen and patches of American elm lies Crooked Lake Provincial Park.

The park is the perfect base from which to visit, to explore and to experience the breathtaking natural beauty, history and many activities in the Qu'Appelle Valley.

The park offers a service centre featuring modern facilities with hot water, hair dryers, flush toilets, and shower facilities in the day-use area. Campers can choose from a variety of activities including fishing or water-related activities, golfing at Last Oak Golf Course three kilometers southeast, hiking, bicycling and photography. Nearby beaches on both Crooked Lake and Round Lake give the chance to work on the perfect suntan.

The day use area features a large irrigated lawn, perfect for a picnic or game of softball, a service centre, and creative playground. If boating is part of your plans there's an excellent boat launch facility with a fish filleting building for successful anglers. Boat docking is available by the campground.

The campground is very picturesque featuring a canopy of trees and many lakeside sites. Crooked Lake Provincial Park features more than 70 campsites including 38 electrified and 21 seasonal (You can go online to book a site at www.saskparks.net). Park entry is \$7 daily, \$17 for a three-day pass, and \$50 for a transferable annual pass. The passes are good for admission to any provincial park. An electrified campsite is \$22 with non-electrified \$17 (out-of-province camping rates apply to non-Saskatchewan residents).

This quiet park is situated in the Qu'Appelle Valley at the east end of Crooked Lake. The park is 40 km south of Melville on Hwy. #47 and 15 km east on Hwy. #247.

The park includes a variety of the valley's unique landscapes. Explore its well-defined coulees and wide open hillsides. Take in the scenic beauty of the valley. Enjoy viewing a variety of wildlife and plant communities.

There is lakeside camping and picnicking under a canopy of Manitoba maple and poplar trees. Many of the campsites have electrical service. The park also features a service centre, a camp kitchen, irrigated lawns and a playground.

Fishing for walleye, pike and perch is excellent.

Come and enjoy a quiet, relaxing visit. Don't be surprised if the peace and tranquility of the valley brings you back!
