



## Bangor Heritage Days popular event

The residents of the tiny community of Bangor have long been known for their ability to throw a party.

Every year this community of about 50 swells in population several times to accommodate visitors to Bangor Heritage Days -- July 18 this year.

One of the highlights of this annual event is a parade of about 60 floats, including antique cars and machinery along the main street of the village about 15 kilometers east of Highway 9 near Waldron.

A few hundred people line the parade route to cheer on friends and relatives who travel to Bangor for Heritage Days from area communities such as Melville, Yorkton, Esterhazy and Stockholm.

Other highlights of the day include displays in the old school building, threshing demonstrations, an all-faith church service and, of course, lots of food.

the community spirit of small-town Saskatchewan during summer need only head to Bangor.

Local ATV enthusiasts hold a derby in the village every year in early April.

The community host a fall supper each year in October but the exact date wasn't set at press time. And as it has in recent years, Bangor residents will host a Remembrance Day ceremony at the village's cenotaph Nov. 11.
